Bob-Tom loved his work. He loved his toys. He loved to water and snow ski. But nothing compared to the love for his family. He liked to joke about the fact that he lived in a house full of women. But he always said it with a smile in his eyes.

We loved Bob-Tom for his keen sense of saying things the way they were, for teaching all our kids how to ski, for his wonderful sense of humor, for helping put up camp (and then tear it down), for supplying the club with real coffee until we finally bought our own pot, for cooking great omelettes for breakfast, for helping Gene with cocktails... the list goes on.

I am still have trouble believing that Bob-Tom is actually gone. I can't imagine what this summer will be without him. The kids, Courtney and Ashley, still want to come out to the river so we will do what we can to make sure that happens.

Bob-Tom & Stephanie first joined the Rats in 1986. Their first trip was July 12-13, 1986. They drove their pretty, 17', yellow & orange boat with a 115 hp Merc for the club on July 26 & 27, 1986. Over the years, Bob-Tom has owned a bunch of boats. He took a break from water skiing with the club when the kids were born but has been very actively involved again since 1995.

The funeral was standing room only. It was obvious to all, that Bob-Tom was very much loved. We miss you.

Big Sky-

Big Sky Resort is developing the north side of Lone Peak for the 2003/2004 ski season adding over 1000 new acres to the resort. The new Moonlight expansion will include a 2 mile long, six passenger high speed lift accessing the new intermediate and advanced terrain.

Horizon Air is offering new non-stop jet service between Los Angeles (LAX) and Bozeman (BZN) on Saturdays from Dec. 21, 2002 through March 22, 2003.

Reaping Olympic Rewards-

Attendance numbers from the February 2003 Freestyle FIS World Championships at Deer Valley Resort indicate that the Olympic spirit is alive and well in Utah.

As part of 2003 Utah Winterfest, an Olympic anniversary celebration, the event included more than 200 athletes from over 24 countries. Total participation in all events, concerts and celebrations drew close to 30,000 spectators.

Mammoth Museum-

It's official. The Beekley Collection — now a museum-size assemblage of ski paintings, posters, pins, magazine graphics and one of the world's outstanding ski libraries — will take up residence at Mammoth Lakes, California.

The Collection will be housed in a former college building, Edison Hall, located on 86 acres, given to the Mammoth Lakes Foundation by Southern California Edison. As a museum/gallery, the Beekley Collection in Edison Hall will be open to the public six or seven days a week. Renovations are underway, and expects to open within a year.

Telus Ski/Board Festival—

In its 8th year, the TELUS World Ski and Snowboard Festival is set to shake Whistler with a stunning array of sports, music and visual arts events for ten action-packed days—April 11-20, 2003.

Ski Designer Dies –

Maria Bogner, the ski fashion designer who changed the face of the ski world in the early 1950s with the stretch pants for skiers, died November, 2002 in Tegernsee, Germany, at the age of 88.

Until the Bogner revolution, skiwear was a world of navy blue and black gabardine. Suddenly, Maria Bogner unleashed what turned out to be a fashion bombshell. Not only was the baggy look out but the sleek, slinky look became available in over 40 bright and exciting colors.

Maria, wife of Willy

Bogner, was part of an intensely skioriented family which made its mark on the ski world also through the racing successes of their children, and the ski films of **Willy Jr**.

Work Out of Erik Schlopy

Claim to fame: Ranked third overall in 2001 World Cup standings for GS; two World Cup podium finishes for 2001; Silver at 2003World Championships for GS.

Fit thought: "Skiing's an athletic sport, so I choose exercises that involve athleticism. The power clean hits all the major muscle groups, and it involves coordination and timing."


Targets: Total body, emphasis glutes, hamstrings, and shoulders.

How to: With the barbell on the floor, legs flexed, lift the bar in one motion to your thighs, bringing the shoulders back and chest out. From there, lift with your shoulders in a shrugging motion, bringing the bar up to your collarbone (see photo). Elbows should end up under the bar, out front.

Reps & sets: Start with just the barbell, and work your way up in weight as you get stronger. Build to 3 sets of 12, then add weight and drop the reps.


Erik's tip: Before you go to the gym, pop a ski video into the VCR to get fired up. "The Ski Team has highlight videos of winning runs playing in the gym. We lift because we have a goal in mind — we're lifting to win."
